This is not an especially elegant version of the appellation nor does it have the intense minerality of the best examples yet it is compelling in its own right. 2021+ (91-93/100)”

“A highly floral and spicy nose of elegant and ripe red pinot fruit and earth nuances that transfer over to the complex, intense, powerful and mineral-driven medium weight plus flavors that possess excellent detail and ample tannin-buffering extract on the superbly persistent and firmly structured finish. This should amply reward long-term cellaring and overall, this is a Pommard that combines power with finesse. In a word, terrific. 2024+ (91-94/100)”
