- 1. 2019 Mâcon-Villages, Joseph Drouhin \$4 taste, \$18 btl. >> \$15.30 on 6 mix**
100% Chardonnay. This is a bright, fresh and lively Chardonnay. The nose offers up pretty meyer lemon and green apple notes. On the palate it is both juicy and clean with a lean, mineral finish. Utterly delicious, easy to love Chardonnay from a top producer. L.R.
- 2. 2019 Pouilly Fuisse 'La Marechaude,' Saumaize-Michelin \$7 taste, \$50 btl. >> \$42.50 on 6 mix**
100% Chardonnay. Biodynamic. This is among the finest estates in the Macon, focusing on single vineyard wines. The 2019 La Marechaude is beautiful, complex and structured Chardonnay, rivaling the quality of the best Cote de Beaune village level wines. Simultaneously rich and fine. Opens with aromas of ripe pear and quince with a whiff of stone. Sleek and mineral on the palate with the nose amplified. Finishes long and with just a spark of salinity to brighten the impression. Exceptional.
- 3. 2017 Chorey-les-Beaune, Joseph Drouhin \$5 taste, \$34 btl. >> \$28.90 on 6 mix**
"The 2017 Chorey-lès-Beaune Village is a little muted on the nose at first, gently unfolding to offer raspberry preserve and crushed strawberry aromas. The lightly spiced palate is medium-bodied with supple tannin, good weight in the mouth and a tang of white pepper that lingers on the aftertaste. Good body and presence here." - 4. 2018 Barbera d'Alba Superiore, E.Pira (Chiara Boschis) \$6 taste, \$40 btl. >> \$34.00 on 6 mix**
100% Barbera. This is a bold, lush Barbera. Dark cherries and spice on the nose. The body is medium to full with inky fruit, bright mint and sage notes and moderate tannins. Delicious and heady now, this is a wine that will continue to improve over the next five years. Limited quantity. L.R.
- 5. 2017 Alpilles Rouge, Dom. de Trévallon \$12 taste, \$86 btl. >> \$73.10 on 6 mix**
50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Syrah "The 2017 Alpilles Rouge is flat-out delicious. Ripe, plummy and forward, the 2017 offers tremendous immediacy. If I didn't know how well Trévallon ages, I would be tempted to set an earlier drinking window, but the best is clearly yet to come. Next to other vintages that display a good bit of ripeness, the 2017 remains medium in body and silky. Sweet red berry fruit, flowers, cedar and earthy notes lead into the vibrant, translucent finish. I hope I can capture just how captivating the 2017 is." Antonio Galloni, Vinous Media
